Participants are asked to host an event of 1 or more Tesla's and to play the custom show in the evening. The cars can be parked in a formation, on the driveway, in a field, or in front of some impressive landmark, it's really up to the individual but the most important thing is that this event is all inclusive and above all FUN.

WHAT TO EXPECT

The show files will be made available for download at www.XLightShows.io on the morning of the Saturday 3rd August 2024. The participants will download the folder named “LightShow” onto a blank memory stick formatted to EX-FAT. Instructions on how to download can be found here: <https://youtu.be/R8AytwnJ4kU>

Once the car(s) are in place, the participants will need to place the memory stick into the USB data port within the car. This is in the glove compartment in most models but can also be in the centre console for Model 3’s prior to 2021. It is important to note that not all models are compatible with custom light shows. ALL Model Y & 3 Tesla ARE compatible, but only Model S & X manufactured after 2021 will be able to play a custom show.

Once the USB stick is inserted, the participant should open the TOYBOX and select the Light Show icon at the bottom of the display. From there you should be able to select the Custom Light Show from the dropdown list and schedule the start time using the toggle.
